The children thoroughly enjoyed their drum workshop today and learned a lot about the various drums available from all around the world.

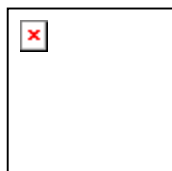
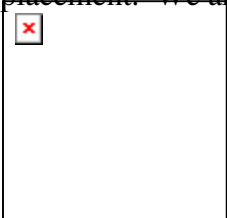
"Sleeping Beauty" Pantomime ~ 11th February 2008
