teaching staff from September. I am sure she will be a very positive addition to our staff.

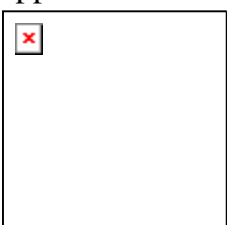
YEAR 5 RESIDENTIAL TRIP

We are pleased to be able to offer piano and recorder lessons again from September 2010. Mrs Kirby BSc (Hons) CTAbrsm has taught music at the school for four years. Tuition is tailored to every child's individual needs, with opportunities to be entered for exams, play in concerts and perform with others. Individual recorder sessions and piano lessons are offered. Group recorder sessions are also available, which spreads the cost amongst 2, 3 or 4 pupils, and enables friends to enjoy lessons together. Twenty minute individual or group recorder sessions cost £6 and an individual thirty minute piano lesson or group recorder session costs £8.
