Skipping for the British Heart Foundation

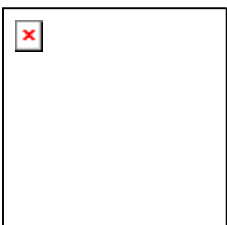
Our skipping activity will be on Wednesday 27th June. I hope sponsorship is going well.
