We are very pleased with the results and congratulate all of the children and staff for achieving such high standards.

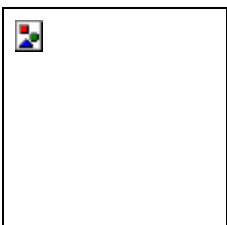
### Her Majesty’s Inspectorate Visit
